## 12.00pm Psycho (1960)

One of the most influential suspense movies of its time and featuring one of the most iconic scenes in film history, Alfred Hitchcock's Psycho takes audiences on a thrilling journey as an unsuspecting victim visits the Bates Motel and falls prey to one of the screen's most notorious psychopaths.

## 2.05pm Creepshow (1982)

Two of the most venerable names in the horror field, author Stephen King and director George A. Romero, present this anthology of original twisted tales inspired by the E.C. horror comics of the 50's and 60's. The most fun you'll ever have being scared!

## 4.15pm A Nightmare On Elm Street (1984)

In Wes Craven's classic that launched a movie franchise, a hideously scarred paedophile who was murdered by a lynch mob returns in the terrifying nightmares of his killers' teenage children, killing them in their sleep.

## 6.10pm Alien (1979)

In space, no one can hear you scream. A close encounter of the third kind becomes a Jaws-style nightmare when an alien invades a spacecraft in Ridley Scott's sci-fi horror classic. Alien blends science fiction, horror and bleak poetry into a seamless whole.

## 8.20pm Dawn Of The Dead (1978)

One of the most compelling and entertaining zombie films ever, George A Romero's sequel to Night Of The Living Dead perfectly blends pure horror and gore with social commentary on bourgeois society.

## 10.40pm The Omen (1974)

A hit among critics and audiences hungry for more after The Exorcist, a mixture of Gothic horror, mystery and graphic kills follows a young boy suspected of being the personification of the Antichrist, accompanied by a masterful Oscar-winning score.
